HOW DO I QUALIFY PROGRAM?

Admission to the Kimble Swing Bed Program requires:

- A minimum 3-night stay at Kimble or other hospital
- Acceptance by a Kimble Hospital physician
- Traditional Medicare coverage

Who is eligible for the Kimble Swing Bed Program?

The Kimble Swing Bed Program is for Medicare patients who require:

- Teaching and training to care for a new health problem or condition
- IV Therapy
- Physical Therapy to Strengthen
- Palliative Care (as an alternative to Hospice)
